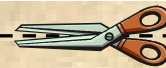


# Description of classes



## 1. Know your Digital Camera : 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

Ever wonder what all those little symbols on your camera mean? They mean that we can teach you to take better photos! In this class we will explain the most common camera settings, when to use them, and how to avoid common errors. PLUS you get our 25+ page handbook to take home.

### 8. 7 Gypsies Accordion Mini Purse Album (Intermediate to Advance class): 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m.

This is the perfect crafty scrapbook holder! It comes with an 8 page accordion chipboard foldout, which makes a perfect mini scrapbook/brag book. Now all you need to add is your imagination and some embellishments to complete this little treasure.

During class we will decorate and assemble the purse, and also decorate the mini album using paint and scrapbook paper.
